

## 2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Eastern Chapter of Oregon Women for Agriculture is pleased to announce they are sponsoring multiple scholarships with prizes ranging up to \$3,500.

## Priority for these scholarships will be given to students pursuing a career/degree in agriculture.

## Scholarship Criteria:

- 1) Must be a female student either attending school or residing in: Baker, Malheur, Morrow, Umatilla, Union, or Wallowa Counties.
- 2) Must be attending a trade school, vocational school, community college or other accredited school for the 2024-2025 school year.
- 3) Applicants may be either high school seniors or existing college/trade school students.
- 4) Funds must be used for tuition and books with the scholarship being deposited directly to the winner's chosen school after proof of enrollment.
- 5) The selected scholarship recipients must be willing to sign a waiver allowing OWA to use their name, home town, and picture in promotions.

To submit an application for a scholarship please fill out this form and attach an essay between 500 and 1000 words. The essay topic needs to be "What is one of the biggest challenges facing agriculture today and how I plan to be a part of the solution". Any essays that are direct copies from previous years will be disqualified.
